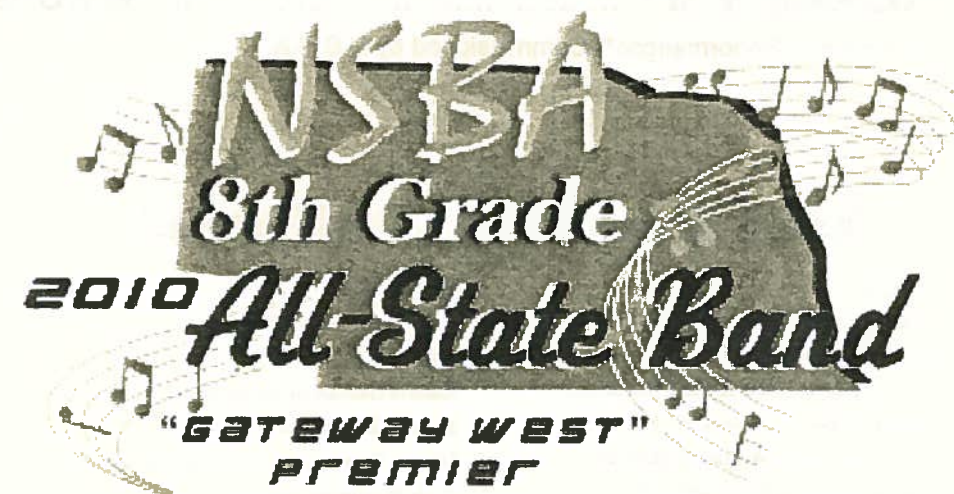

John O'Reilly is one of the most-performed composers of band music in the world today with 350 compositions and arrangements in print. A recipient of numerous ASCAP awards, he has studied composition with Robert Washburn, Arthur Frackenpohl, Charles Walton and Donald Hunsberger. As co-author of the *Yamaha Band Student*, *Accent on Achievement* and *Strictly Strings*, John has made a major impact on the education of young musicians.

John attended the Crane School of Music, State University of New York at Postdam, receiving a Bachelor of Science degree. In addition, he is the recipient of a Master of Arts in Composition and Theory from Columbia University.

John's 12 years of teaching experience at elementary through college levels has provided him with insights and sensitivities to the needs of both students and educators. For thirty five years he served as Executive Vice President and Editor-in Chief for Alfred Publishing. An elected member of the prestigious American Bandmasters Association, John is a frequent conductor of honor bands worldwide.
